



## Exchange Program for Students

ANU operates a program for its students to study for a certain amount of time (six months to one year) at universities overseas while they are enrolled, and to have their overseas studies credited towards their degree. This program provides students with broad educational opportunities for experiencing advanced learning and foreign cultures and expanding their views. It is expected that the number of countries and students participating in this program will gradually increase.



# ADMISSION INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

## UNDERGRADUATE COURSE

- **Time** : On a specified day in May and November each year
- **Qualifications for freshman admission**
  - 1) Korean residents in foreign countries or foreigners with educational backgrounds of graduation from regular high schools or more in Korea or other foreign countries
  - 2) People at level 3 or more in TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean)
- **Qualifications for transfer admission**
  - 1) The same qualifications as in undergraduate course
  - 2) Those who have completed two years' undergraduate course in Korea or overseas
  - 3) Those who have completed courses at two-year junior colleges, higher level institutions, or at equivalent educational organizations in Korea or overseas and have attained degrees or are expected to attain degrees

## GRADUATE COURSE (FOR MASTER'S AND DOCTORAL DEGREE)

- **Time** : On a specified period in May and November each year
- **Common Requirements** : Foreign students, Korean residents in foreign countries, or foreigners who have completed courses equivalent to the college or university
- **Master's Course** : Those who have completed regular courses of college or university in Korea or overseas, and have attained or are expected to attain Bachelor's degree
- **Doctoral Course** : Those who have completed regular courses of college or university in Korea or overseas, and have attained or are expected to attain Master's degree

## KOREAN LANGUAGE COURSE

- **Opening** : on a specified day in March and September each year
- Foreigners who graduated from regular high school or a higher level of educational organizations
- **Class** : forty weeks (800 hours) per year with 20 weeks' basic course and 20 weeks' intermediate course divided
- These courses are intended for foreigners who would like to learn Korean. These courses also provide opportunities for learning Korean culture and tradition.



# INTRODUCING ANDONG

Andong, the Capital of Korean Spiritual Culture, has the fragrance of history and keeps the breath of tradition alive.


## Andong City

Andong has a broad layer of cultural history which is combined with folklore, Buddhism, Confucianism and recent Christianity. Andong has cultural values that are not religiously biased and has cultural assets that are not focused on a certain era. In addition, the cultural value of each asset is excellent. The practical philosophy and Confucian life of Neo-Confucianism played an important role in producing the greatest number of Korean patriots for the independence movement. As a result, tangible cultural assets and intangible cultural assets with various values are passed down abundantly both in quantity and quality in this region.



### Hahoe Village Important Cultural Asset No.122

It is a representative clan village for the Pungsan RYU family. The village name, Hahoe (Ha means a river and Hoe means turning around), originates from the fact that the Nakdong-gang river which flows around the village in an S shape. Hahoe Byeolsingut Mask Dance Drama, and Seonyujulbul Nori are still preserved in the village, so it is the most suitable traditional folk village to understand the traditional culture of Andong. The village was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site on July 31st, 2010.




### Dosan Seowon Historical Site No.170.

This academy was built to celebrate and commemorate the scholarship and virtue of LEE Hwang who was called Toegye, or Haedongjooja and to educate Confucian scholars. In the structural viewpoint, the academy is divided into Dosanseodang and Dosanseowon. Dosanseodang is the place where Toegye personally taught his followers, whereas Dosanseodang was built after his passing. Andong lake is located in front and a dense pine forest surrounds its back, so one can feel charm and lyricism.




### Wolyeonggyo

It is the biggest and longest wooden bridge in Korea (length : 387m, width : 3.6m). It was named by collecting citizens' opinions: from the submerged Wolyeongdae, which was moved here due to Andong dam construction and from its place name, Eumdalgol, Wolgok-myeon. A fountain is installed to the bridge, and one can enjoy the whole view of the dam from Palgakjeong pavilion which is located on the middle of the bridge.



### Byeongsan Seowon Historical Site No. 260.

At first, this seowon was located in Pungsan-hyeon with the name of "Punggakseodang." Great Master RYU Seongryong moved it to the present location in 1572 (fifth year of King Seonjo) to educate Confucian scholars. In 1614 (fifth year of King Gwanghaegun), local Confucian scholars built a shrine for him and started Hyangsa (memorial ceremony) praising the mentor's achievements and deep studies. Byeongsanseowon faces a beautiful rock cliff of Hwasan mountain which stands across the Nakdonggang river in front of the village. It is famous for its vista and excellent architecture.



### Andong International Mask Dance Festival

*Duration: September 25 to October 4, 2015*

For several years, Andong International Mask Dance Festival has been consecutively designated as a representative Korean festival. In order to globalize Korean traditional culture, this festival is held in October every year.

### **At the intercity bus terminal**

- Take a taxi or bus no. 1 or 11 and travel thirteen kilometers in the direction of Yeongdeok from the terminal in the following order.
- Bus terminal ▶ Train station ▶ Beopheung-gyo bridge ▶ Yongsang-dong ▶ Seoneodae ▶ ANU
